Dear Customers and Partner,

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Authority Agency (CISA), Department of Homeland Security, released a Memorandum on Identification of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers during the COVID-19 Response. CISA executes the Department of Homeland Security's responsibilities as assigned under the Homeland Security Act of 2002. CISA uses trusted partnerships with public and private sector interests to deliver infrastructure resilience assistance and guidance.

CISA has developed an initial list of critical infrastructure workers to help state and local officials identify sectors, sub-sectors, segments, and critical functions that should continue normal operations. In addition to sectors involved directly in health care and public safety, other sectors are listed that aid national defense and economic interests.

Defense Industrial Base is a listed critical sector, as its workers support essential services required to meet national security commitments to the federal government and US Military. It includes personnel working for contractors and subcontractors.

Safran Power USA, Ilc located in Sarasota Florida clearly falls within the Defense Industrial Base critical sector. This facility supports the following critical military programs:
