**Re: Mexico Closure and Force Majeure Update**

Dear Valued Aptiv Customer:

The Mexico Secretary of Health has ordered the immediate suspension of non-essential activities in Mexico until April 30, 2020 due to COVID-19. Our industry is not included in the list of essential activities requiring Aptiv to immediately suspend its activities in Mexico.

Since January we have provided several communications to you regarding the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting force majeure situation, including not only the health impact of the virus itself but also the impact on Aptiv and its suppliers to obtain materials and produce and deliver products to Aptiv's customers.

This Mexico order adds to the government lockdowns, quarantines, travel restrictions, and border closures, stay-at-home orders and compulsory country-wide closures of non-essential businesses already in effect in other countries. Even efforts to work from home are becoming more difficult as internet network bandwidth is stretched to capacity and beyond. These extraordinary government actions taken to contain or slow the spread of COVID-19 are completely outside of Aptiv's and its suppliers' control and continue to be a force majeure event.

Many of our customers have already temporarily suspended or dramatically reduced production and development activity, but with government-imposed restrictions growing by the day, we feel it is important to notify you that Aptiv may no longer be able to support even reduced production or development activity until these restrictions abate. Anticipated ramp-up efforts may also be impacted.

As before, we will continue to communicate with the appropriate contacts at your location regarding specific production, delivery or development activity that is no longer possible due to this force majeure. We will also continue to provide timely updates and necessary information as circumstances change.
